

TORQUE CHART

Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torques.



8 mm flange bolt	26	2.7	20


USE AND CARE INFORMATION

- When the windscreen becomes dirty, rinse it thoroughly with cool water to remove loose dirt, then wipe with a clean cloth or sponge.
- Never use organic solvents such as gasoline, thinner or benzine to clean the windscreen. Also do not use acid or alkaline cleaners to clean this accessory.
- If the motorcycle is left covered for an extended period of time, park in the shade. Parking a covered motorcycle in direct sunlight can cause the windscreen to deform due to heat buildup under the cover.
- Check the windscreen mounts frequently and retighten if necessary.




Remove the motorcycle's headlight unit.






2. Using a shop towel to rest the windscreen on, assemble the following parts as shown. Tighten the 6 mm stepped screws to the specified torque.






3. Using two people, loosely tighten the windscreen subassembly on the motorcycle.




4. Install the motorcycle's headlight unit as shown.



Remove the corresponding unit-side bolts and attach the right and left stays with a 6 mm flange bolt and long collar as shown.

Align the mark on the headlight case with the alignment mark on the motorcycle. Tighten the 6 and 8 mm windscreen stay bolts to the specified torque.



CHECK AFTER INSTALLATION

Check the headlight for proper operation and beam adjustment.
